



CSQE EXAM COACHING

OBJECTIVES

The purpose of this self-paced coaching session is to help candidates prepare themselves for the Software Quality Engineer examination offered by the American Society for Quality. The examination is intended to test a candidate's knowledge of all of the areas of information used by the modern day SQE in his/her profession. The cost is \$285.

This session is done remotely and is designed to allow examinees to prepare for the CRE exam entirely at their own pace and timing and interface with the instructor via email and phone. The session will include the following:

- 5) Updated study notes to take into the exam

The latest revision of the CSQE Examination is a 4 hour, exam to be taken in one session. The exam will consist of 160 questions (including case studies).

The Body of Knowledge consists of seven areas:

- I. Introduction to the CSQE, General, Knowledge, Conduct, and Ethics (16 questions – 10%)
- II. Software Quality Management (30 questions – 18.75%)
- III. Software Engineering Processes (26 questions – 16.25 %)
- IV. Program and Project Management (24 questions – 15%)
- V. Software Metrics, Measurement, and Analytical Methods (24 questions – 15 %)
- VI. Software Verification and Validation (24 questions – 15 %)
- VII. Software Configuration Management (16 questions – 10 %)

This session cannot teach a candidate the entire Body of Knowledge required to be a Software Quality Engineer in one session. It will, however, do three things for the candidate:

1. Provide an overview of the entire field of Software Quality Assurance and thereby refresh the candidate's knowledge of the field.
2. To identify new areas in which the candidate may wish to increase his / her knowledge.
3. To provide direction for self-study and practical insights to coping with the exam.
